Part 2 - Details of Departmental Appropriations

2.1 - Departmental Output Expenses

Investigation and Resolution of Complaints About Government Administration (M78) (A31)

Scope of Appropriation

This appropriation is limited to the investigation, resolution of complaints and the provision of advice relating to central and local government administrative actions, monitoring compliance with international conventions, and the provision of advice and support for international ombudsman communities and forums.

Reasons for Change in Appropriation

This appropriation decreased by \$3.493 million to \$47.300 million for 2022/23 due to:

- a decrease of \$5.563 million for an expense transfer to 2023/24. This is due to the continued direct and indirect impact of COVID-19 on the Ombudsman's annual work programme, resulting in a number of scheduled projects being deferred for completion in 2023/24
- an increase of \$2.070 million for an expense transfer from 2021/22. This was sought to help mitigate the effects of COVID-19, and ensure the Ombudsman can continue to deliver high quality services and carry out delayed projects from the annual work programme.

2.2 - Departmental Other Expenses

Remuneration of Ombudsmen PLA (M78) (A31)

Scope of Appropriation

This appropriation is limited to remuneration expenses for the Ombudsmen as authorised by sections 8 and 9 of the Ombudsmen Act 1975.

Reasons for Change in Appropriation

The increase in this appropriation by \$42,000 to \$505,000 for 2022/23 is due to an adjustment to determination by the Remuneration Authority.
