#### Reasons for Change in Appropriation

This appropriation increased by \$443,000 to \$17.407 million for 2023/24 is due to:

- an increase of \$261,000 to fund the provision of electronic forensic investigation services by the Serious Fraud Office funded by Immigration New Zealand, the Financial Markets Authority, and the **Commerce Commission**
- an increase of \$80,000 for Crown Law Office utilisation of the Serious Fraud Office in Auckland, funded by the Crown Law Office
- an increase of \$55,000 for the SFO to represent New Zealand in hosting the International Foreign Bribery Taskforce meeting in Auckland funded by the New Zealand Police, and for the SFO to attend the OECD review in Canada funded by the Ministry of Justice, and
- an increase of \$47,000 for assistance to the Vanuatu Office of Public Prosecutors, funded by the Ministry of Foreign Affairs and Trade.
