This appropriation increased by \$2.400 million to \$27.652 million for 2024/25 due to a \$3.400 million increase in cost recoveries, primarily from the New Zealand Defence Force, offset by \$1 million transferred to out-years due to the timing of costs over the capability management life cycle.

Reasons for Change in Appropriation

This appropriation increased by \$123.702 million to \$938.220 million for 2024/25 due to:

 a transfer of \$396.813 million from 2023/24 to 2024/25 and a transfer of \$292.398 million from 2024/25 to 2025/26 of unused headroom in the appropriation to accommodate: the accounting of potential foreign exchange movements affecting the reported New Zealand dollar value of hedged foreign currency expenditure; and the uncertainty of the timing of prepaid monies being recognised as capital expenditure under accounting standards for capabilities being acquired under the United States Foreign Military Sales programme

- the approval of three new defence capability projects: Operational and Regulatory Aviation Compliance Sustainment Tranche Phase Two C, Utility Vehicle replacement - Tranche One, and Updating Classified Digital Services Phase 1, totalling \$30.925 million in 2024/25
- the budgets for eight capability projects increasing by a combined \$7.261 million for non-cash technical adjustments to accommodate the increased reported New Zealand dollar value of hedged foreign currency expenditure.

These were offset by the realignment of tasks within two capability projects between the Ministry and the New Zealand Defence Force: Maritime Sustainment Capability, and Future Air Mobility Capability -Tactical, resulting in a decrease in the Ministry's appropriation of \$18.899 million. There is no change in the overall combined project budgets.
