## 2.1 - Departmental Output Expenses

Workplace Relations and Safety - Employment Relations Services (M43) (A17)

Scope of Appropriation

This appropriation is limited to information, guidance, investigation, enforcement, dispute resolution services and decision-making regarding employment relationships and standards, including support services provided to employment relations institutions.

#### Reasons for Change in Appropriation

This appropriation decreased by \$791,000 to \$45.295 million for 2024/25 due to a Cabinet decision to transfer out \$800,000 to reflect the Immigration Fee and Levy review. This decrease was partially offset by a Cabinet decision of \$9,000 to transfer New Zealand Parole Board Roles from the Cabinet Fees Framework to the Remuneration Authority.

#### ACC - Rehabilitation Entitlements and Services (M1) (A17)

Scope of Appropriation

#### Scope of Appropriation

This appropriation is limited to information, education, leadership, guidance, support, and enforcement relating to the health and safety of workers and workplaces.

#### Reasons for Change in Appropriation

This appropriation increased by \$9.644 million to \$133.776 million for 2024/25 due to a Cabinet decision of \$9.734 million to fund WorkSafe's Public Sector pay adjustment. This increase was partially offset by a technical adjustment of \$90,000 to correct the Budget 2024 Plant and Structures savings initiative.

## 3.4 - Non-Departmental Other Expenses

Workplace Relations and Safety - Employment Relations Authority Members' Salaries and Allowances PLA (M43) (A17)

Scope of Appropriation

This appropriation is limited to the salaries and allowances of the members of the Employment Relations Authority, as authorised by section 171 of the Employment Relations Act 2000.

Reasons for Change in Appropriation

This appropriation increased by \$65,000 to \$7.471 million for 2024/25 due to a forecasting adjustment in relation to the Remuneration Authority determinations on Employment Relations Authority members remuneration and allowances.

Workplace Relations and Safety - Remuneration Authority Members' Fees, Salaries and Allowances (M43) (A17)

Scope of Appropriation

This appropriation is limited to the fees, salaries and allowances of the members of the Remuneration Authority.

Reasons for Change in Appropriation

This appropriation increased by \$2,000 to \$332,000 for 2024/25 due to a Cabinet decision to transfer New Zealand Parole Board Roles from the Cabinet Fees Framework to the Remuneration Authority.

## Reasons for Change in Appropriation

This appropriation increased by \$112.094 million to \$633.383 million for 2024/25 due to:

- a Cabinet decision of \$108.259 million to reflect the Immigration Fee and Levy review, and
- a Cabinet decision of \$4.340 million to fund the Our Future Services programme that will create a fit for purpose immigration system.

This increase was partially offset by:

- a fiscally neutral adjustment of \$460,000 to Vote Social Development to support the transfer of accountability for the Refugee Drivers Training Programme, and
- a fiscally neutral adjustment of \$45,000 to Vote Internal Affairs to support the transfer of accountability for the Language Assistance Services programme.
