Community and Legal Assistance Scope

- **noted** that Joint Ministers agreed to establish the *Community Justice Support and Assistance* non-departmental appropriation as a multi-category appropriation in Vote Courts from 1 July 2021;
- **noted** that this appropriation was created to consolidate a number of smaller appropriations and enhance the flexibility in allocating funds based on evolving priorities, including the *Community Legal Assistance* category;
- **noted** that it has become apparent that the scope of this category within the appropriation needs to be amended in order to allow funding for support programmes and agencies;
- agreed to amend the scope previously approved as follows:
