A transfer is required from the nondepartmental category to the departmental category for this initiative in 2024/25 to meet these costs. This change is being progressed as a technical initiative because Cabinet's approval is required to transfer funding into and out of the Flexi-Wage Employment Assistance category of the multi-category

appropriation (MCA) [CAB-20-MIN-0493].

Title: Support Funds to Provide Costs of Disability Assistance to

Disabled People

Description: The purpose of Support Funds is to increase the participation of

disabled people or people with a health condition in open employment, by assisting them with additional costs incurred as a direct consequence of their disability or health condition, when

undertaking the same employment or training as a person

without a disability or health condition. This includes specialised equipment, assistive software, New Zealand Sign Language Interpreters, transport and a specialist support person. There are savings in the current financial year which can be utilised to meet an expected increase in demand for this service and

operational costs in the outyears. An expense transfer is required to transfer funding from 2023/24 to 2024/25 through to 2026/27.

Title: Transfer of the Forensic Coordination Service

Description: The Forensic Coordination Service (FCS) is a specialist service

that provides needs assessment and service coordination for people accessing the High and Complex Framework, which itself provides for the compulsory care and rehabilitation of approximately 200-250 people with an intellectual disability who have committed imprisonable offences. The FCS has transferred to Whaikaha's direct control, reflected by the reforecasting of funding between categories of the *Supporting Tāngata Whaikaha Māori and Disabled People* appropriation.
